### **WEEKDAY WORSHIP**

**Like waiting for a bus all three of our saints this week turn up on one day, Monday. Chronologically the first is Felix apostle of the East Angles (died 647) whose see was centred on the town of Dunwich in Suffolk now lost to coastal erosion.**

**Edward King (died 1910) was a saintly principal of Cuddesdon theological college, professor at Oxford and ultimately bishop of Lincoln. Theologian and pastor – volumes of his pastoral letters were published – his championing of Catholic ritual as well as theology led him into court cases for such shocking things as the use of candles on the altar.**

**Geoffrey Studdert Kennedy – Woodbine Willie – (died 1929) is remembered for his compassion for the ordinary soldiers of WW1 and his commitment to industrial chaplaincy afterwards. What joins these three diverse characters? The outworking of God's multi-faceted love.**
